Gardener

Responsibilities / Specific Duties:

- Assist with mulching, light pruning, deadheading, and weeding throughout the year
- Plant the seasonal displays including tulips bulbs, summer annuals, and seasonal vegetables
- Maintain clean pathways and sidewalks, allowing visitors to walk through the garden with ease
- Answer occasional visitor questions about gardening and plants

- Ability to follow directions, personable manner, and excellent communication skills
- Flexible to shifting priorities

- Not required to work when it's raining, snowing, below 45°F in winter, or above 90°F in summer
