• Crafty Cultivator

Mission & Purpose:

- The Crafty Cultivator is an integral member of the team at PJCBG, creating the holiday blooms and other seasonal displays that will be admired by thousands of visitors each year. They work closely with PJCBG staff to represent the Garden and establish a welcoming and educational experience for a diverse audience.

Responsibilities / Specific Duties:

- Create holiday blooms from recycled bottles. Examples of flowers include tulips, magnolias, daffodils, dogwood, lotus, and lilies.
- Clean bottles, cut to shape, paint, and affix to strands of lights.
- Track type and number of flowers created.
- Create seasonal holiday displays for the pavilion and welcome center front door.
- Maintain an orderly workspace.

Qualifications:

- Willingness to learn and work as a team
- Professionalism and ability to follow directions
- Personable manner and excellent communication skills
- Interest in gardening and sustainability preferred
- Have a specific garden hobby or special craft you would like to share? Let us know!
- 18+ (special consideration may be given to students 16+ requiring community service hours)

Time Commitment:

- Minimum of one 3-hour shift in a 12-month period.
- Workdays are scheduled weekly on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 9am-12pm or 1pm-4pm. An occasional Saturday morning workday may be scheduled.

Location / Working Conditions:

- Inside Horticulture Building at work tables
- Must be able to sit/stand/climb stairs
- Ability to use scissors and snips, spray paint, and/or soldering iron
- May be exposed to fumes from spray paint and melted plastic

Training & Support:

- Orientation
- Shadow / hands-on training with staff member or other volunteers
